CANDIDATE SURVEY

Lifespan sent the following nine-question survey to each candidate for U.S. Senate, U.S. House of Representatives, Michigan House of Representatives, County Commissioner and various township offices in Wayne, Oakland and Macomb Counties. (A separate Judicial Candidate Survey was also mailed to candidates for Appeals, Circuit, District, Probate Court and County Prosecutor offices. See pages 24-27.)

1. The 1973 U.S. Supreme Court *Roe v. Wade* decision allows for abortion for any reason, even as a method of birth control, even in the late stages of pregnancy. Do you **SUPPORT** the reversal of this decision?
2. Do you **SUPPORT** a law banning partial-birth abortions, except to prevent the death of the mother?
3. Some public funds are used for abortions or abortion referral. Do you **OPPOSE** the use of public funds for abortion or abortion referral, except to prevent the death of the mother?
4. Human embryonic stem cells and human fetal tissue are used in some medical experimentation which has no beneficial effects for the fetus. Would you **SUPPORT** legislation that would prohibit the use of embryonic stem cells and fetal tissue in such experiments?
5. Would you **SUPPORT** a law banning so-called “reproductive cloning”—cloning meant to result in the birth of a baby?
6. Knowing that the removal of stem cells from human embryos results in the death of those embryos, would you **SUPPORT** a law banning so-called “therapeutic cloning” (somatic cell nuclear transfer)?
7. Do you **OPPOSE** laws allowing assisted suicide?
8. Do you **SUPPORT** honoring the wishes of patients who want life-saving treatment (including food and water) regardless of their degree of disability, age and “quality of life”?
9. Do you **SUPPORT** legislation that would protect health care professionals from being forced to distribute medications or provide medical care that violates their moral or religious beliefs?

NOTE: Lifespan is not a political organization and does not endorse candidates for election. We have surveyed the candidates as a service to our members. Each contraceptive has a particular action that makes it effective. Fully understanding this action (or actions) will assure the user of any possible abortive properties. Right to Life - LIFESPAN urges those considering artificial means of contraception to be fully informed as to the actions of that contraceptive, and to reject those medications and devices that prohibit the newly conceived baby from implanting on the uterine wall, being nurtured there for the nine months of pregnancy, and being born into the world.

For whom does one vote, when it comes to the office of President of the United States? One candidate is a radical pro-abortionist who will confirm liberal Supreme Court Justices and put in place new policies that will keep the killing fields of abortion active for the next 30 years—another 50 million babies will die. So, please, **vote**, and then continue to work with Lifespan. Encourage more people to join Lifespan. Then, for the next election, we will have more pro-life people working with us to change hearts and minds, one heart at a time.
