More Intense Pain-Save the Babies!

DID YOU KNOW? “At 20 weeks, the fetal [preborn baby] brain has the full complement of brain cells present in adulthood, ready and waiting to receive pain signals from the body, and their electrical activity can be recorded by standard EEG,” Dr. Paul Ranalli, neurologist, University of Toronto for preborn children. Dr. Ranalli says that 20 weeks is a “uniquely vulnerable time, since the pain system is fully established, yet the higher level pain-modifying system has barely begun to develop.” As a result, *preborn babies at this age probably feel pain more intensely than adults.* Despite the fetus’s (preborn baby’s) advanced development at 20 weeks, horrific abortion procedures are used. Life BEGINS at Conception

DID YOU KNOW? There is a significant amount of misinformation circulating regarding human fertilization, embryo implantation and the first week of life. Here are the **known scientific facts:** What is present *at conception* is an *entire new human*, even though it is yet a single cell.
