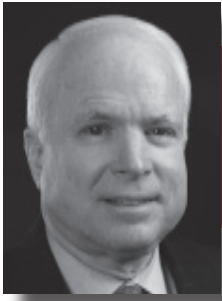

Where Do the Candidates Stand on Abortion?

**Note: The "Freedom of Choice Act" is a bill that would make partial-birth abortion legal again, provide for taxpayer funding of abortion, and invalidate virtually all state and federal limitations on abortion, such as parental notification laws.*

Roe v. Wade

- Voted to oppose *Roe v. Wade*, the Supreme Court decision that allows abortion for any reason.
- "...We would be better off by having *Roe v. Wade* return to the states....I don't believe the...Court should be legislating in the way that they did on *Roe v. Wade*."

- Co-sponsor of the "Freedom of Choice Act."*
- "I have consistently advocated for reproductive choice and will make preserving women's rights under *Roe v. Wade* a priority as President."

Partial-Birth Abortion Ban

***Note: Gonzales v. Carhart is the April 2007 Supreme Court decision upholding the constitutionality of the federal Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act.*

The partial-birth abortion procedure — used from the fifth month on — involves pulling a living baby feet-first out of the womb, except for the head, puncturing the skull and suctioning out the brain. The great majority of partial-birth abortions are performed on healthy babies of healthy mothers.

- Voted for the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act.
- "Today's Supreme Court ruling [in *Gonzales v. Carhart***] is a victory for those who cherish the sanctity of life."

- "I am extremely concerned that [*Gonzales v. Carhart***] will embolden state legislatures to enact further measures to restrict a woman's right to choose, and that the conservative Supreme Court justices will look for other opportunities to erode *Roe v. Wade*."

Taxpayer Funding of Abortion

- Voted in favor of the Hyde Amendment, which prohibits taxpayer funding of abortion through the Medicaid program.
- Voted consistently against federal funding of abortion.

- Voted against legislation in the Illinois State Senate that prohibited taxpayer dollars from being used to pay for abortion.
- His campaign has stated that he "does not support" the Hyde Amendment, which prohibits taxpayer funding of abortion through the Medicaid program.

Parental Notification Law

- Voted to support a bill that would have required an abortionist to notify at least one parent before performing an abortion on a minor girl from another state.

- Voted to block a bill that would have required an abortionist to notify at least one parent before performing an abortion on a minor girl from another state.

Protecting Abortion Survivors

- Voted for legislation that provides protection for babies who survive abortions equal to protection received by babies who are spontaneously born prematurely.

- Voted three times against a bill in the Illinois State Senate that would have provided protection for babies who survive abortions equal to protection received by babies who are spontaneously born prematurely.

CANDIDATE SURVEY

Lifespan sent the following nine-question survey to each Republican and Democratic candidate for U.S. Senate, U.S. House of Representatives, Michigan House of Representatives, County Commissioner and various township offices in Wayne, Oakland and Macomb Counties. (A separate Judicial Candidate Survey was also mailed to candidates for Appeals, Circuit, District, Probate Court and County Prosecutor offices. See pages 20-23.)

1. The 1973 U.S. Supreme Court *Roe v. Wade* decision allows for abortion for any reason, even as a method of birth control, even in the late stages of pregnancy. Do you **SUPPORT** the **reversal** of this decision?
2. Do you **SUPPORT** a law **banning** partial-birth abortions, except to prevent the death of the mother?
3. Some public funds are used for abortions or abortion referral. Do you **OPPOSE** the **use of public funds for abortion or abortion referral**, except to prevent the death of the mother?
4. Human **embryonic** stem cells and human **fetal** tissue are used in some medical experimentation which has no beneficial effects for the fetus. Would you **SUPPORT** legislation that would **prohibit** the use of embryonic stem cells and fetal tissue in such experiments?
5. Would you **SUPPORT** a law **banning** so-called “reproductive cloning”—cloning meant to result in the birth of a baby?
6. Knowing that the removal of stem cells from **human embryos** results in the death of those embryos, would you **SUPPORT** a law **banning** so-called “therapeutic cloning” (somatic cell nuclear transfer)?
7. Do you **OPPOSE** laws **allowing** assisted suicide?
8. Do you **SUPPORT** honoring the wishes of patients who **want** life-saving treatment (including food and water) regardless of their degree of disability, age and “quality of life”?
9. Do you **SUPPORT** legislation that would protect health care professionals from being forced to distribute medications or provide medical care that violates their moral or religious beliefs?

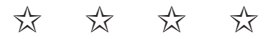

Absentee ballots

According to Michigan law, you are eligible to vote by absentee ballot if one of the following applies: You are 60 years of age or older; you will be out of town on election day; you prefer to vote absentee because of illness, physical disability or religious tenets; you are confined to jail awaiting arraignment or trial; you are an election precinct inspector in a precinct other than the one where you preside. To get an absentee ballot simply call or write to your city, township or village clerk and ask for an absentee voter application. Or, apply in person to the clerk and fill out a standard form. If you want the ballot mailed to you, your application must be received by 2:00 p.m. on the Saturday before an election date. Your vote must reach your local clerk before the polls close on election day at 8:00 p.m.
