What: National Day of Remembrance of Aborted Children – Annual Memorial

When: Saturday, September 10, 2016 at 1:00 pm

Where: White Chapel Cemetery, Troy

Why: *Right to Life - LIFESPAN* will offer a memorial service at the grave site of five babies whose lives were lost to abortion in 1980 at White Chapel Cemetery, 621 W. Long Lake, Troy, MI on September 10, 2016 at 1:00pm.

The remains of these babies were found in a self-storage facility, identified only as “medical waste”. After an investigation into their deaths by the Oakland County Prosecutor, their bodies were released to *LIFESPAN* for burial.

At 1:00 pm, visitors will gather at the gravesite and remember these little ones whose lives were so brief. We will offer them the dignity that was denied them in life—a sense of mourning at their deaths and a remembrance of their lives.
