Michigan Nurses For Life

At last year's Spring conference, we asked the participants what topics they would like addressed at our quarterly meetings for 2004-2005. One of the most frequently mentioned was the issue of post-abortion syndrome. This is the issue that many who promote abortion say does not exist. They remark that occasionally a woman will have fleeting doubts about her abortion decision, but the feeling most often reported is one of relief.

Well, clearly, those folks do not hear the same kind of heartbreaking stories that we hear. A nurse is looked on as a listening ear, someone that can be trusted not to judge or condemn so we frequently hear of the emotional pain and loss of self esteem that accompanies a decision to abort.

On January 11, 2005, psychologist LuAnn Adams will address our 3rd meeting of the year and tell us of her experience in post-abortion counseling. In speaking with LuAnn, I mentioned that women seeking her counsel must be very fragile. She suggested to me that it was a strong woman who sought help. The evening promises to be enlightening to all who come in contact with the aftermath of abortion.


Life Chain



Abortion and the Supreme Court

hanks to your hard work and strong support,
President Bush was re-elected with a clear and
convincing win over pro-abortion candidate John
Kerry. Exit polls showed that Americans placed
the highest priority on moral issues, such as abortion.

Now that the president has been re-elected, a new battle begins. That's the fight to reform the U.S. Supreme Court by putting new members on it who are pro-life or, at minimum, will not read into the Constitution that a so-called right to abortion exists.

President Bush has promised to appoint such "strict constructionists" to the court, just as he appointed numerous pro-life judges to key federal courts during his first term.

However, on the day President Bush accepted a call from John Kerry conceding the race and hours after tens of millions of Americans celebrated, pro-abortion Republican senator Arlen Specter told a news conference that it was "unlikely" that judicial nominees who oppose the horrendous *Roe v. Wade* Supreme Court decision would be approved once he becomes the new chairman of the Senate Judiciary Committee.

All appointments of Federal judges, including the Supreme Court, must go through the Senate Judiciary Committee. The Chairman can elect to call up a nominee or refuse to do so.

President Bush will have the opportunity to appoint anywhere from one to three new Supreme Court justices during his term. If you want those new judges to be prolife or favor overturning the *Roe v. Wade* decision, the time to act is now.

In order to move a pro-life judicial nominee through the Senate confirmation process, we need a Senate Judiciary Committee chairman who is not pro-abortion and who will allow nominees to have a fair hearing and an up or down vote. That won't happen if Senator Arlen Specter (R, Pennsylvania) is the chairman. Very soon, Senate Republicans will vote on new leaders for the next Senate. If a majority of the members of the Judiciary Committee speak up in opposition to Specter leading the committee, the entire Republican caucus may vote on a replacement.

Send the Republican Senators a message that they should not elect Sen. Specter as Chairman of the Judiciary Committee. To elect Senator Specter as Chairman of this committee where he could oppose President Bush's nominees is too big a risk to take. If Senator Specter considered a nominee "too conservative" he could kill the nomination.

Specter is a well-known figure to anyone who is even the least bit familiar with the pro-life movement. During his time in the U.S. Senate, he has been nothing short of a champion for the pro-abortion forces. In 1987, Senator Specter played a key role in keeping pro-life Judge Robert Bork, a Reagan nominee, from taking a seat on the Supreme Court. In 2001, Senator Spector told C-SPAN that he would withhold confirmation from any nominees who refused fidelity to the *Roe v. Wade* decision. Most recently, it is reported that Specter re-affirmed his commitment to the pro-death movement by warning President Bush not to nominate a pro-life judge for the court.

It is almost certain that, if appointed as chairman of the judiciary committee, Senator Specter will wreak havoc with his pro-abortion zealotry by enforcing a strict litmus test for judical nominees. The senator's beliefs about who should be nominated to the Supreme Court are certainly a form of bigotry against those who know that abortion is a heinous act that kills an innocent child.

If you're pro-life and care about stopping abortion, please do the following and urge pro-life friends and family to do the same.

- If either of your senators is a Republican, call or write and urge opposition to Senator Arlen Specter becoming the next chairman of the Senate Judiciary Commit tee. Editor's note: Unfortunately, both of Michigan's senators are pro-abortion. (That is why it is so important to vote!)
- Contact members of the Senate GOP leadership or the entire 55-person membership of the Senate Republican caucus. See web site: www.grasswave.com/notspecter/faxin.php
- Contact Senate Majority Leader Bill Frist and Rick Santorum and tell them "No on Arlen Specter for judiciary chair." Give them your name and address and request a reply.

From the President's Desk

Dear Friends,

The election is over! It was a glorious day for the pro-life movement. My thanks to all of you who worked to help make this day a day to remember. Every vote, every prolife discussion on the issues, every volunteer moment paid off on November 2.

Listening to the media, the day after the election, I felt that those with strong moral values spoke loudly enough, with one voice and were finally heard. As usual, media discussion of the election referred to "religion and religious zealots." It is obvious that the main street media just doesn't get it. Killing 4000 little human beings in this country every day is not what most of the good people in the USA will continue to accept as normal. Love of God, love of country and love of children and family and good moral values are paramount.

We must not forget what this election also means for our Supreme Court. The interpretation of laws by Supreme Court justices needs to be done using sound judicial knowledge of the constitution and not by the emotional and/or political whims of the jurist. Justice Rehnquist spoke out with clarity and truth, and his opinion at the time was very unpopular. His health is failing now. I wrote a get-well message to him recently on behalf of Lifespan and our members. I thanked him for his courage and prayed for his health.
