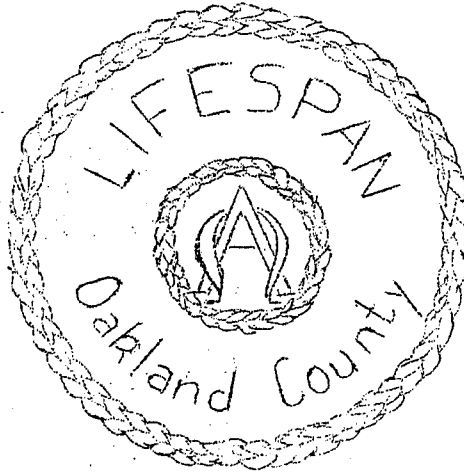

Dear Fellow Pro-Lifers:

It is with great pleasure that we introduce to you our first Lifespan Oakland County Newsletter. Hopefully, it will be sent monthly to all of our paid members. On alternate months, it will be an insert with the bi-monthly state-wide newsletter.

A short history of your organization might be in order to clarify and identify the different pro-life groups. Shortly after Black Monday, January 22, 1973, "People Taking Action Against Abortion" was renamed LIFESPAN in order to clearly identify our philosophy concerning life. We knew we were no longer dealing with just abortion, but all aspects of human life from the beginning to the end. Our objective has been that of promoting respect for all human life regardless of age, color, affliction or "wantedness".

LIFESPAN belongs to "Michigan Citizens for Life", a state coalition founded in the summer of 1973 which maintains the same pro-life philosophy, but whose goals and objectives are to unify all pro-life groups in Michigan. MCL is supported financially by the individual pro-life organizations within the state.

The "National Right to Life" has been working to unify the nation-wide groups. Although each of these state organizations maintains its own autonomy, our objectives are all basically the same: to educate the people of the United States to the pro-life story, and to work for a Human Life Amendment to the Constitution which will guarantee that most basic right to all members of our society -- that right to LIFE!!

The LIFESPAN Oakland County Newsletter has been created to keep you abreast of our local pro-life activities. We hope you will find it informative, and we welcome any comments or suggestions.

After reading the newsletter, please pass it on to a friend in the hope that your friend will join LIFESPAN, thereby becoming a member of our society who is not afraid to courageously take a stand for life.

Looking forward to sharing the latest with you in forthcoming issues.

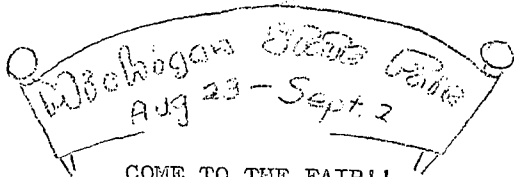

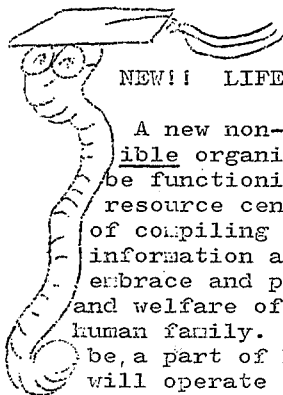


COME TO THE FAIR!!

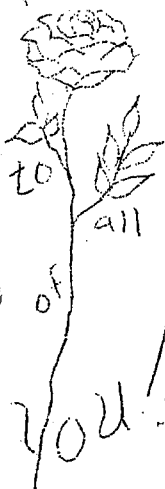
